2013-2014	2	<b>Abraham Lincoln High School</b>	Funds will be used to pay for transportation to/from two local art museums, admission to Denver Art Museum.
2013-2014	2	<b>Amesse Elementary</b>	Funds will be used to publish and print a student literacy magazine featuring student writers. The magazine will consist of poetry, stories, essays and artwork. This year marks the second edition of this publication.
2013-2014	2	<b>Archuleta Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase new history and geography library books to support the 4th grade United States research project. Teachers mix traditional research with hands-on learning in order to appeal to multiple learning styles.
2013-2014	2	<b>Asbury Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase ukuleles and tuners for the music program. The instruments will be used in collaboration with composition activities and instruction in harmonic accompaniment.
2013-2014	2	<b>Bradley International School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase standards-based instructional materials and experiences related to the school's International Baccalaureate curriculum.
2013-2014	2	<b>Brown International Academy</b>	Funds will be used to purchase standards-based instructional materials and experiences related to the school's International Baccalaureate curriculum.
2013-2014	2	<b>Career Education Center Middle College of Denver High School</b>	Funds will be used to offset airline costs for students to attend the Middle College National Consortium (MCNC) conference.
2013-2014	2	<b>Carson Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to provide a field trip for all third graders to South Platte Education Center and all fifth graders to Opera Colorado.
2013-2014	2	<b>CMS Community School (Schenck Elementary School)</b>	Funds will be used to offer Play-Well TEKologies LEGO programming for students
2013-2014	2	<b>Colfax Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to bring in hands-on labs for 4th and 5th grade students from the Denver Museum of Nature and Science. Planned topics include "Energy at Play," "Forensics," "Rocket Wars," and "Colorado Native."
2013-2014	2	<b>College View Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase materials that support small group literacy intervention and positive behavior programming and curriculum.
2013-2014	2	<b>Columbian Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to send 5th grade students to High Trails Outdoor Education Center to experience the mountains, explore nature and participate in team building and confidence building activities.

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2013-2014	2	<b>Contemporary Learning Academy High School</b>	Funds will be used to implement Xpress Yourself workshops to support literacy skills development and positive leadership development.
2013-2014	2	<b>Cowell Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase drums and equipment for a World Drumming ensemble.
2013-2014	2	<b>DPS Dept. of Gifted and Talented</b>	Funds will be used to support the successful implementation of the DPS Shakespeare Festival. Purchased items include ribbons for students, t-shirts for security and stage managers and posters to advertise the Festival.
2013-2014	2	<b>DPS Dept. of Library Services</b>	Funds will be used to purchase one book for each student at Goldrick Elementary School. At the book distribution, students will participate in literacy activities and parents will be invited to attend and participate alongside their children.
2013-2014	2	<b>Denver Center for International Studies at Fairmont</b>	Funds will be used to subsidize an overnight trip at the Denver Museum of Nature and Science for fourth and fifth grade students. Additionally, monies will be used to purchase sleeping bags that students may "check out" to alleviate the extra expense of overnight trips.
2013-2014	2	<b>Denver Center for International Studies</b>	Funds will be used to purchase a school membership to Denver Open Media to produce videos and television programs.
2013-2014	2	<b>Denver School of the Arts</b>	Funds will be used to offset lodging expenses for the Stagecraft & Design students' trip to Ft. Worth, TX. Students will attend a conference to learn about the newest techniques, products and services in the entertainment and theatre industries.
2013-2014	2	<b>Doull Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to allow third grade students and students with special needs to learn about Colorado history with hands-on lessons with historical artifacts and two "in-class" field trips taught by professional historians.
2013-2014	2	<b>Edison Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to pay for hippotherapy sessions for students with autism and the transportation necessary to attend these sessions.
2013-2014	2	<b>Ellis Elementary School</b>	Continue the tradition of producing a yearbook to be given free to all students. Students work as the primary contributors to the design, layout, photography and editing of the yearbook.
2013-2014	2	<b>Escalante-Biggs Academy</b>	Funds will be used to purchase active learning tools for children to practice their letters and sounds. Magnifying glasses allow children to explore the school garden in an active, hands-on way. Books will also be purchased to supplement classroom libraries.
2013-2014	2	<b>Fairview Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to provide students with special needs time in the community for experiential learning opportunities.

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2013-2014	2	<b>Florida Pitt Waller ECE-8 School</b>	Funds will support a fieldtrip for 8th graders to Washington, DC to learn US history, geography, and government outside of the classroom creating life-long learners.
2013-2014	2	<b>Grant Ranch ECE-8 School</b>	Funds will be used to enhance the school's Positive Behavioral Intervention and Support program by rewarding students who demonstrate good behavior.
2013-2014	2	<b>Greenwood Academy</b>	Funds will be used to increase students' science achievement through building a camera and using it and art to document the making of a school garden.
2013-2014	2	<b>Gust Elementary School</b>	Funds will allow third graders to participate in swim lessons at the local YMCA. Additionally, funds will be used to allow fifth grade students to participate in the Denver Parks and Rec.'s "Discover Snowshoeing" program to instruct students about various aspects of winter survival and outdoor education, including learning about food webs, winter adaptation, watersheds, and conservation of the surrounding ecosystem.
2013-2014	2	<b>Hallett Fundamental Academy (Knight Fundamental Academy)</b>	Funds will be used to purchase a one-year subscription to an online math program and rewards for students reaching their reading goals.
2013-2014	2	<b>Harrington Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to allow students to participate in the "Bunk with the Beasts" overnight program at the Denver Zoo and offset costs of a field trip to Clear Creek History Park and Astor House Museum for third graders.
2013-2014	2	<b>Henry World Middle School</b>	Funds will be used to support the school's movie and book clubs - funds will be used to purchase multiple copies of books, magazines, teaching materials, audio books, transportation to view first run movies based on literature, etc.
2013-2014	2	<b>Johnson Elementary School</b>	Students will attend the Butterfly Pavilion and Four Mile Historic Park. Additionally, students will make real-world connections for college readiness with a visit to CU Boulder tour and student panel discussion. Students will also participate in the encore program at the Denver Children's Theatre.
2013-2014	2	<b>Kaiser Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase interesting and fun math manipulatives to excite students about math.
2013-2014	2	<b>Kepner Middle School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase audio equipment to enhance the school's student-run school news program.

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2013-2014	2	<b>KIPP Sunshine Peak Academy Charter School</b>	Funds will be used to pay for transportation and admission costs of the End of Year trips for fifth grade students. Fieldtrips include Denver Zoo, Museum of Nature and Science, and the Colorado History Museum.
2013-2014	2	<b>Knapp Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase interactive student response system devices to promote full-class participation and engagement throughout lessons and provide real-time feedback on student progress.
2013-2014	2	<b>Lowry Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to provide scholarships to 4th grade students to attend the Keystone Science School.
2013-2014	2	<b>Math and Science Leadership Academy</b>	Funds will be used to bring the Hawkquest program - teaching students the importance of different raptor species, their specially adapted tools, and their role in the ecosystems.
2013-2014	2	<b>McGlone Elementary</b>	Funds will be used to purchase drums to enhance the education and character of the students through the "Drumming Up Character" program.
2013-2014	2	<b>Merrill Middle School</b>	Funds will be used to create and implement a healthy eating and cooking enrichment class for the school's refugee student population.
2013-2014	2	<b>Montbello High School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase Crossman Challenger PCP Competition Air Rifles for the JROTC marksmanship program and teams. The air rifles will be used to compete in the city, state, regional and national level competitions.
2013-2014	2	<b>Montclair School of Academics and Enrichment</b>	Funds will be used to purchase books for 25-30 girls for use in the Ladies Literature Lunch monthly book clubs.
2013-2014	2	<b>Morey Middle School</b>	Funds will be used to pay for a portion of Destination Imagination - an educational program in which student teams solve open-ended challenges and present their solutions at a regional tournament.
2013-2014	2	<b>Newlon Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to offset expenses of the fifth grade students' outdoor education program at Plains Conservation Center. Students will learn traditional Cheyenne skills, including cooking, painting, hunting and sleeping in a tipi.
2013-2014	2	<b>Place Bridge Academy</b>	Funds will be used to support an expeditionary science program for multi-intensive special needs students. The program includes field trips to the zoo, science museum, botanic gardens, etc.
2013-2014	2	<b>Sabin International Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to pay for transportation for students to attend and participate in the Special Olympics - basketball, soccer and track & field.

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2013-2014	2	<b>Schmitt Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used to sponsor a Girls on the Run team, which instills self-esteem and strong values through health education, life skills development, mentoring relationships and physical training.
2013-2014	2	<b>Skinner Middle School</b>	Skinner 6th grade students will attend the 9News Weather & Science Day at Coors Field to experience real life science and math experiments. Students will also have the opportunity to attend a Rockies game.
2013-2014	2	<b>Southmoor Elementary</b>	Funds will be used to bring in a science speaker who will teach the 5th grade students how to build a simple electric motor. Part of the funding will be used to purchase owl pellets and another portion will be used to purchase science items for a raffle drawing.
2013-2014	2	<b>Stedman Elementary School</b>	Funds will be used for an all-day excursion to open space lands to hike and rock climb with members of the Colorado Mountain Club.
2013-2014	2	<b>Summit Academy</b>	Funds will be used to implement a Positive Behavior Intervention and Support program to promote attendance, appropriate behavior and academic achievement.
2013-2014	2	<b>Swigert International School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase materials to support social-emotional development for students in preschool through middle school ages through formats such as one to one support, small group intervention and whole-class instruction.
2013-2014	2	<b>Thomas Jefferson High School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase equipment to mic bands and actors for the school's drama performances.
2013-2014	2	<b>Traylor Academy</b>	Funds will be used to help build literacy skills including automaticity, expression, background content knowledge, and link reading to writing. Students will be able to research a central topic of their choosing and write, edit and publish their own non-fiction book.
2013-2014	2	<b>Trevista at Horace Mann ECE-8 School</b>	Funds will be used to purchase RTD bus tickets to allow multi-intensive students to travel to community events, Special Olympics and the grocery store.
2013-2014	2	<b>West Career Academy</b>	Funds will be used to purchase outdoor clothing and gear to allow students to participate in Outward Bound activities
2013-2014	2	<b>Whittier ECE-8 School</b>	Funds will be used to implement three cultural assemblies - bringing in resources from metro Denver to expose students to the wealth of artistic resources in the city.
