Noble Energy, in Partnership with the Denver Broncos, Supports DPS Foundation and Barnum Elementary
Organizations join together for a day of service followed by check presentation

Denver—On Wed., Sept. 12, [Noble Energy](#) and Denver Broncos employees will join together at Barnum Elementary for a daylong volunteer project benefiting students and the school. The employees will read one-on-one with the students, clean and paint classrooms and hallways, weed gardens and plant trees, before taking 50 fifth-grade students on a field trip to Broncos Stadium at Mile High for a presentation of a \$35,000 check to the Denver Public Schools (DPS) Foundation.

The day of service coincides with Noble Energy’s “Global Day of Caring,” a day in which Noble employees from Colorado and around the world volunteer their time in their local communities. The Day at Barnum continues Noble’s longtime commitment to positively impact students in DPS. The activities also mark Noble Energy’s partnership with the Denver Broncos in “The RedZone Program.” Each time the Broncos offense enters the redzone during a home game, Noble Energy makes a \$1,000 donation to the DPS Foundation. The Broncos reached the redzone 35 times at home during the 2017 season. Over the past four seasons, Noble Energy, in partnership with the Broncos, has donated more than \$135,000 to the DPS Foundation to catalyze change for Denver students.

“Barnum Elementary is honored to be chosen for this day of service, and we deeply appreciate the dedication and service of the volunteers. Visiting Broncos Stadium at Mile High is an experience our fifth graders will always remember. It is amazing to feel this level of support from our community,” said Barnum Elementary Principal, Beth Vinson Grabois.
